Subject : Immediate corrective measures in response to ongoing measles outbreak in Bangladesh.

Sir,

As per information received, severe measles outbreak are ongoing in Bangladesh reporting a number of confirmed cases since March, 2026 across the country. Media reports highlighted over 100 child death in last few weeks indicating widespread transmission and gaps in immunization coverage.

As the CADC area in Lawngtlai District, Mizoram sharing international border with Bangladesh it is alarming situation and recommended to be vigilant regarding identification and reporting the measles cases and outbreak.

All fever with rash cases (suspected measles) in any age group should be reported immediately.

A. For School Education Department (EO to take action through school authorities):-

1. Immediate Reporting: All suspected cases (any child/person with fever and rash) identified in schools must be reported immediately to the nearest Health Facility.
2. Coordination with Health Department/WHO Consultant: Ensure close coordination with Health Department and WHO Consultant for timely investigation and response.
3. Infection Prevention Measure: Teachers and Anganwadi Workers must be sensitized to identify symptoms of fever with rash and promptly report such cases. Daily vigilance should be maintained for early identification of suspected cases.

B. For Village Councils:-

The Local Administration Officer is requested to undertake intensive public awareness activities on priority, including (through all village councils)

1. Dissemination of information on symptoms of measles (fever with rash) and the importance of early reporting.
2. Promoting immediate reporting of suspected cases to health authorities.
3. Advising communities to avoid sending symptomatic children to schools and to maintain efforts for isolation until fully recovered.
4. Announce through Village Crier for wide and effective outreach.
5. Supporting the Health Department and WHO Consultant in risk communication and community mobilisation.
