PPREPACE

It is an immense pleasure and deep satisfaction for the District Council Court, Chakma Autonomous District Council (CADC) to place before all concerned the First Edition of Compilation of its Office Records. The District Council Court functions under the administrative control of Law and Judicial Department, CADC which was constituted in the year 1972 under the provisions of the Pawi-Lakher Autonomous Region (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1954. Despite the long existence and continuous functioning of this department, no such consolidated compilation of judicial and administrative records had yet been published in the history of this Court. However, the consolidation of these records has been fraught with considerable institutional challenges. The Chakma autonomous District Council, as a developing administrative entity, experienced significant transitions over the decades. In particular, the headquarters of the CADC underwent relocation from Kamalanagar to Borapansury and subsequently back from Borapansury to Kamalanagar. During these transitions, a considerable number of records maintained by the District Council Court were inadvertently lost or misplaced, creating substantial gaps in the institutional documentation. These losses represent not merely administrative setbacks but gaps in the judicial and administrative memory of the CADC. Further compounding these challenges is the persistent absence of permanent, purpose-built District Council Court structure. The lack of dedicated infrastructure has necessitated the Court's office to be relocated repeatedly from one place to another within the Kamalanagar. Each transition was undertaken manually without the aid of modern logistical support systems, which has incrementally resulted in the further loss and displacement of vital records. The accumulative effect of these multiple relocations -each executed with considerable institutional effort, has meant that many records from various periods remain scattered, incomplete, or entirely inaccessible. These institutional difficulties have underscored the pressing need for a comprehensive and systematic documentation initiative.

This compilation comprises a comprehensive collection of all cases, judgments and various official documents issued by this Department, including Affidavits, Deeds & Agreements, Heirship Certificates, Succession Certificates, Marriage Certificates and other legal instruments that reflect the multifaceted judicial and administrative systematic documentation initiative. This endeavor, therefore, marks a significant milestone in the institutional development and administrative consolidation of the Law and Judicial Department, CADC, symbolizing both a preservation of its judicial heritage and a forward-looking commitment to transparency, order and systematic organization of its records. At the same time, the Department considered not publishing the detailed personal or individual records available with it in order to safeguard their sensitive nature and to protect the privacy of all concerned persons.

The administration of justice is not merely confined to the fair and impartial adjudication of disputes; it also encompasses the vital responsibility of preserving, organizing and ensuring accessibility of judicial and administrative records. The maintenance of

authentic, systematic and comprehensive records constitutes the very foundation of judicial transparency and administrative accountability and institutional continuity. The absence of unified compilation of records had long been perceived as a lacuna within this Court's institutional framework. With the successful completion of the first volume, the long-felt necessity has now been effectively fulfilled. This compilation is envisioned to serve as a valuable and enduring reference not only for the judicial officers and staff of this department but also for Advocates, Litigants, Researchers, Academicians and all other stakeholders who wish to acquaint themselves with the functioning, precedents and administrative framework of the District Council Court, CADC. It will undoubtedly strengthen the internal record-keeping mechanism, promote administrative efficiency and enhance the understanding of the procedure of this Court. Moreover, it stands as a visible testament to the commitment of this institution towards the ideal of efficiency, order and the rule of law.

The Law and Judicial Department, CADC, hopes and firmly believes that this work shall remain a guiding instrument and a reliable companion in the noble pursuit of justice within the Chakma Autonomous District Council for years to come. Despite the institutional challenges that have hindered the preservation of the records, this compilation represents a renewed commitment to documentation, record preservation and administrative excellence within the judicial system of this Autonomous Council.

LAW AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT/DISTRICT COUNCIL COURT,

CHAKMA AUTONOMOUS DISTRICT COUNCIL.

Introduction:

The Chakma Autonomous District Council (CADC) was set up under the Provisions of Article 244(2) read with Sixth Schedule of the Constitution of India by a notification issued on 2nd April, 1972 by the Government of Mizoram. Though the notification was issued on 2nd April, 1972, the Chakma Autonomous District Council officially begun its functions from 29th April, 1972.

Judicial Courts in the Chakma Autonomous District Council were established under the “Mizoram Autonomous District Council (Constitution and Conduct of Business) Rules, 1974”. This was officially notified on 21st January, 1975, in pursuance of paragraph 2(6) of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India. The notification was issued by the Administrator of Mizoram and published in the Mizoram Gazette, Volume Aizawl, Issue No. 72(A) dated 18th August, 1989, but the original rules date to 1974 with the notification in 1975 for their enforcement. Courts in Chakma Autonomous District Council initially began to functions as per the Provisions of “Pawi-Lakher Autonomous District Region (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1954”. Judicial Courts in the Chakma Autonomous District Council are set up under Sub-Paragraph 4(1) of Paragraph 20 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India to try all cases between same tribe of the local area of the Council in Customary, Civil and Criminal natures where punishment on conviction is less than 5 (Five) years of imprisonment in normal circumstances. However, the Governor may also empower the District Council Court of the CADC with the power of Session Judge under Sub-Paragraph 5(1) of Paragraph 20 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India as done to Khasi and Garo Hills Autonomous District Council Courts. An appeal against the judgment of the District Council Court lies only in the concerned High Court. But in Mizoram, criminal cases are not yet sent by the police in the District Council Court of all the 3 (Three) Autonomous District Councils.

Three Tier Courts System:

Courts in the Chakma Autonomous District Council (CADC) are divided into 3 (Three) tier system:

1. The District Council Court or the appellate Court of its Subordinate Courts.
2. The Subordinate District Council Courts.
3. The Village Councils Court.

1. **The District Council Court:** As per Hon’ble Gauhati High Court, The District Council Court shall have the power to try cases of all Chakma Customary Law, civil and criminal cases within its jurisdiction, triable by a Magistrate of First Class including the following Sections of Indian Penal Code, 1960 : - 129, 133, 135 to 138, 140 to 145, 152, 153(B5), 154, to 159, 161 to 171 (in respect of public servant removable by District Council Court), 171D, to 171, 172 to 190 (so far as consent relates and authority set up by District Council), 193, (part), 201 (part), 214 (part), 215, 216 (part), 217,218,221 (part), 223, 225, 225 (part), 225A, 225D, 229, 233, 235, 237,241, 242, 246, 248, 252, 254, 261, 263 to 267, 269 to 280, 282 to 289, 291 to 298, 304A, 306 (part), 309, 312 (part), 318, 324, 332, 334 to 338, 385, 403, 404 (part), 406, 411, 414 to 419, 421 to 425, 427, 428, 434, 448, 451 (part), 453, 454 (part), 456, 461, 462, 465, 468 (part), 482 to 489E, 491, 498, 500

to 502, 504, 505 (part), 508 and 509. It can also take up appeals of its Subordinate Courts as well as Village Council Courts which fall under its jurisdiction.

2. **Subordinate District Council Courts:** The Subordinate District Council Courts have the power to try cases of all Chakma Customary Law, civil and criminal cases within its jurisdiction, including the following Sections of Indian Penal Code, 1960 : - 129, 133, 135 to 138, 140 to 145, 152, 153 (B5), 154 to 159, 161 to 171 (in respect of public servant removable by District Council Court), 171D to 171, 17 to 190 (so far as consent relates and authority set up by District Council), 193, (part), 201 (part), 214 (part), 215, 216 (part), 217, 218, 221 (part), 223, 225 (part), 225A, 225D, 229, 233, 235, 237, 241, 242, 246, 248, 252, 254, 261, 263 to 267, 269 to 280, 282 to 289, 291 to 298, 304A, 306 (part), 309, 312 (part), 318, 324, 332, 334 to 338, 385, 403, 404 (part), 406, 411, 414 to 419, 421 to 425, 427, 428, 434, 448, 451 (part), 453, 454 (part), 456, 461, 462, 465, 468 (part), 482 to 482E, 491, 498, 500 to 502, 504, 505 (part) 508 and 509. Although, in theory there are 3 (Three) Subordinate District Council Courts in CADC, such as: - a) Subordinate District Council Court of Kamalanagar, b) Subordinate District Council Court of Borapansury, and c) Subordinate District Council Court of Vaseitlang. But currently, none of these Courts exists in Chakma Autonomous District Council due to lack of sufficient staff to run these, Courts.
3. **Village Councils Courts:** Village Council Courts under CADC shall have the power to try cases within the jurisdiction of the concerned Village Council. Although, in some exceptional cases Village Council Courts in CADC may try a case by 1 (One) or more Village Council Courts. In addition, Village Council Courts have the power to try cases of the following Sections of the Indian Penal Code, 1960: - 160 (Affray), 290 (Public Nuisance), 323 (Voluntarily causing hurt), 352 (Assault), 339 (Wrongful Restraint), 379 (Theft from outside dwelling house), 426 (Mischief), 447 (Criminal Trespass), 510 (Appearance in a state of intoxication in public place).

The District Council Court/Law and Judicial Department, CADC, is one of the important pillars of Chakma Autonomous District Council (CADC), created under Para 4(1) of the Sixth Schedule of the Constitution of India. Its main function is to administer justice to the tribal people of the CADC, in customary law, civil and criminal suits and also to issue all legal documents and certificates to the people of the region. Though the Constitution of India provides the District Council Court trial of criminal cases, between members of local tribe (Schedule Tribe), but till date no such cases have been brought up by Police within CADC. Presently, it undertakes cases of customary law, civil and criminal (if brought up) matters whose punishment on conviction is less than 5 (Five) years of imprisonment. The District Council Court/Law and Judicial Department, CADC, is headed by the Court President and Recorder, who is constitutionally invested with the power of a Magistrate of First Class in normal circumstances. He may also be empowered with the power of Session Judge under paragraph 5(1) if the Governor of the State is pleased. The Court President and Recorder are assisted by Judicial Officers and other staff. Besides him, other presiding officers of the District Council Court are also invested with the power of a Magistrate of First Class.

WORK AND BUSINESS OF THE STAFFS:

1. **Court President and Recorder:** He is the supervising authority of the District Council courts. He is empowered with the Magistrate of First Class. He can try cases brought to District Council Court or ask subordinate Judicial Officers to try any particular case.
2. **Court President:** They are the supervisory authority of Subordinate District Council Court.
3. **Judicial Officer-I:** They are to try cases in the District Council Court as endorsed to them. Function as a member of a Particular Bench in an Appeal case.
4. **Judicial Officer-II:** They are to try cases at the Subordinate District Council Courts.
5. **Head Assistant:** He is to supervise all official works.
6. **Assistants:** They are to supervise the file works, one the cash side, one the case side and the other the correspondence side.
7. **Stenographer:** They are to record the Court proceedings.
8. **UDCs:** They are to supervise the LDCs/Peshkars in putting up the file works, typing and also drafts.
9. **LDC/Peshkar/Typist:** They are to initiate and put up cases, correspondence, court certificates and other official works.
10. **Computer Operators:** To do computer typing.
11. **Process Server:** They are necessary to serve court processes like summon, notice.
12. **Office Peon:** They are necessary to attend the officers and ministerial staff and to make file movement and distribution of letters, correspondence.
13. **Chowkidar:** Necessary to look after office buildings.
14. **Sweeper:** To keep the office neat and clean.
15. **Marshal:** For the safety of Presiding Officers of Courts during trial.
16. **Drivers:** They are to drive the vehicles of Presiding Officers.

FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

- 1) Trial of customary, civil and criminal cases.
- 2) Hearing of appeal against the judgement of lower courts.
- 3) Issue of certificates like Marriage, Deed & Agreement, Heirship, Succession, Caste, Adoption, Residential etc.
- 4) Affidavit.
- 5) Agreement.
- 6) Power of Attorney.
- 7) Other legal documents (Agreement of Court Marriage, etc).

POWER AND DUTIES

The power and duties of the Court President and Recorder and the Judicial Officers are to try cases and pronounce judgement apart from issue of certificates and other legal documents. They are empowered with the power of Judicial Magistrate of the First Class in the District Council Court; the Judicial Officer-II's in the Subordinate District Council Courts are to be empowered with the power of Magistrate of Second Class. The other staffs function in the office by initiating trial of cases, issue of court processes, maintenance of records, execution of Court Orders, issue of court process, notifications and maintenance of departmental accounts and properties.

PROCEDURE FOLLOWED IN DECISION MAKING PROCESS INCLUDING CHANNEL OF SUPERVISIONS AND ACCOUNTABILITY

Trial of cases is conducted independently as per the CADC Administration of Justice Rules 2001. An appeal against a judgement is entertained in the Honourable Guwahati High Court, Aizawl Bench. General and financial administration is carried out as per the decision of the Executive Committee of the Chakma Autonomous District Council. Accountability on execution of Executive decision lies with the Court President and Recorder.

RULES, REGULATIONS, INSTRUCTIONS, MANUALS AND RECORDS HELD BY IT OR UNDER ITS CONTROL OR USED BY THE EMPLOYEES FOR DISCHARGE OF ITS FUNCTIONS

The District Council Court follows the Pawi-Lakher Autonomous Regions (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1954, in the trial of cases. It also follows the Chakma Customary Laws Code, 1997 and in spirit the Code of Criminal Procedure and Civil Procedure Code.

The District Council Court, CADC, tried and disposed of several cases since its inception. However, records of cases before 1985, are unavailable with it. The following are the year wise data of cases, tried and disposed of till date by the District Council Court:

(2) The existing Judicial Officer Sri B.L. Dewan who is presiding over the aforesaid Judicial Court shall be the Court the Court President & Recorder of the said District Council Court.

(3) Four Subordinate District Council Courts at Kamalanagar, Borapansury, New-Jognasury and Vaseitlang are constituted with one Judicial Officer for and to preside over each of the said Courts with the villages shown against them below.



2. Trial of and dealing with the customary cases or
other such matters need be carried out under customary law and
this right or power is solely reserved by the respective tribals.
In this regard para 4(1) of the sixth schedule to the constitu-
tion of India may be referred to, which ~~provides~~ provides that
except the District Councils or the District Council Court no
other court below the High court shall have jurisdiction over
any customary cases.

3. Unfortunately many reports are received to the
~~worst~~ effect that some govt. Officers/Officials directly take
up such customary cases for disposal in most of which anticus-
tom action are taken, and the innocent parties being ignorant
of such Officers/Officials not having competence in the custo-
mary affairs find no alternative but to be satisfied with what
so ever action are taken by the said Officers/Officials.

In view of the above the Executive Committee
of Chakma District Council can not but bring home to you ~~that~~
the above facts with the request to issue necessary orders to
~~prevent~~ avoid the miscarriage of the Justice in the customary
cases.

In the meantime the local govt. Officers are

The second noticable devil of such marriage among the local chakmas is that the poor families who can not support even their existing family members ~~are~~ are bound either to go to the Mohajan for ~~loss~~ for the "Mela" of their young boys thereby to lose every thing they may have rendering the ~~family~~ family ~~in~~ in a totally ruined condition or to lose the boys as a "Ghar-jama".
3. The 3rd & the most devestating devil of such marriage is that the young couples are sure to lose their vitality in sex & health in very young stage of their life & they can never be expected ~~to~~ to be able to possess in future a sound health & to restore their "Birjya" (Mental & physical strenght) and thereby they are bound to be ^{physically} ~~plubically~~ & mentally weak & unable to produce any sound or meritorious child, and thereby such families are bound to go down & down in respect of financial physical and mental condition and in such a deteriorating condition of the families, the community itself or even the nation, are the ultimate victim of this devil.

The Govt marriage law & the Chakma Customary Law do not permit such a child marriage, Why ? , because this comes mainly aim at checking the deterioration of the health financial affairs & merits of the progenies & thereby of the community and the Nation in ultimatum.

5. In spite of prevalence of such laws and experiences of the evils of such child marriage, it is yet unchecked and rather is alarmingly increasing day by day among the Mizoram Chakmas.

SUGGESTION

It is therefore suggested that the child marriage in the meaning of marriage of premature girls & boys be stopped by order as soon as may be.

It has been brought to the notice of the Executive Committee that in most cases the Village Council Presidents do not honour the directions or orders of the Court President & Recorder of the Chakma District Council Court that is to say the Village Courts do not obey the orders or directions of the District Council Court which is quite irregular and attracts legal action.

In this regard this is for clarification that the Village Courts are directly subordinate to the subordinate District Council Courts or to the District Council Court and these superior courts have full Jurisdiction over all village courts in respect of all judicial affairs, and as such these courts have inherent power and authority to issue any direction or order to the village courts on judicial affairs and the village courts are bound to obey such orders or directions and a disobedience of such order or direction of the District Council Court or the subordinate District Council courts by any village court shall be a contempt of the superior court and liable to punishment.

Further to clarify that the court president or the judicial officers of the superior courts are the persons to order or direct the village council Courts in the name of the village council/Court Presidents and the village council/Court Presidents are the persons responsible for compliance of such order or direction.

THE CHAKMA CUSTOMARY LAWS CODE, 1997

PRELIMINARY

Preamble :- Whereas the Chakma Customary Law is yet a lex non-scriptis and whereas it is expedient to collect the same and to provide for Administration of the said Law.

Be it enacted in the Twenty fifth year of the Chakma Autonomous District in exercise of the power conferred under the paragraph 3 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India as under :

1. SHORT TITLE :- This shall be called the Chakma Customary Laws Code, 1997, hereinafter referred to as the Law or the Customary Law.
2. COMMENCEMENT :- This will come into force from the date of notification in the Mizoram Gazette.
3. EXTENT AND APPLICATION :- This shall extent to the whole of the Chakma Autonomous District and shall apply to any person whoever may he be, involed in any social or Customary case or matter arising or occuring within the said District area in particular, and shall also be applicable to all Mizoram Chakma in General.
4. SCOPE FOR AMENDMENT :- This may be amended from time to time by the District Council with Gazeite notification.
5. SAVINGS :-
 - (i) If any difficulty in regulating any provision or any question as to the interpretation of any rule or provision of this law arises, the matter shall be referred to the Court President

ORDER.

It is observed that, so far cases came for appeal to the District Council Court, Chakma Autonomous District Council, are without proper documents. Which means the village council courts do not follow the proper procedure of trial. Therefore, it is ordered that, henceforth, on getting any complain from an aggrieved person the Village Council presidents should follow the following procedure:

1. Invite all village council members and other old and experienced persons to be present in the trial.
2. Fix a date, time and place for trial.
3. Summon the accused and complainant.
4. On the trial date.
 1. (a) Record the statement of complainant.
 - (b) Record the statement of accused.
 - (c) Record and obtain signature of v/c members and other elders.
- (2) If the accused admits his/her guilt pronounce judgment after discussion with Members and other old and experience people present in the trial. Which should also be recorded.
- (3) If the accused does not admit his/her guilt –witnesses of both sides should be summoned fixing another date for trial.
- (4) On the day of trial, statements of witness should be recorded. The witness Should also be cross examined and recorded : if the version is not same. Afterwards judgment should be pronounced after discussion with the village Council members and elders present.
- (5) If there is two decision of the v/c members and elders present –it should be recorded and the members and elders should sign on the decision which they Support and the VCP should pronounce the majority decision as judgement.
- (6) Statements should be recorded either in English ,Bengali or, Chakma in simple and lucid manner and preserved.

Copy of judgement should be supplied to complainant and accused.

ORDER

It has come to the knowledge of the District Council Court, Chakma Autonomous District Council that some village Councils are very lenient on SINALI (sex related offences like illicit relation, living together of male and female as husband and wife without marriage, living together without marriage, un-wed pregnancy etc.) Offenders and taking no action against such immoral activities. Some village council members even participate in the wedding of a pregnant or un-wed mother, without taking action against such illicit activities. As a result, such immoral activities are increasing day by day which the District Council Court views seriously. As per custom, SINALI (illicit sexual relation, living together without marriage and un wed pregnancy etc.) is punishable with cash , pig and cock - up to four MHUT(fist measure)of pig and up to Rs. 40/- for male and up to Rs. 20/- and a cock for female (if both are un married or widow and widower), up to five MHUT (fist measure) of pig and Rs. 50/- for male and four MHUT (fist measure) of pig and Rs. 40/- for female (if both are married). The male gets heavier punishment if the relation is with others wife and vise versa. Such punishment was prescribed during the period of Chakma Raja, in the 1930s when the price of a five fist measured pig was said to be about ten ANNA to one Rupee and a labourer would get two ANNA to three ANNA as wages per day; which means a person needed to labour for five to eight days to earn one rupee and is equal to Rs. 600/- to Rs. 1600/- at present day wage valuation !. Due to such strigent punishment, the society remained clean and immoral activities were very rare.(It is said that one has to become bonded labourer to a wealthy person to pay such fine , if he had no fine money !)

It is therefore ordered that, henceforth, on knowing about any SINALI incident like immoral sexual relation, living together without marriage and of un-wed pregnancy, the village councils should initiate action even in absence of any complaint under the process called 'HAGHIM BADI' on behalf of the Chakma District Council. It will also be the duty of the father/guardian of an un-wed pregnant girl to report such incident to his/her village council court. Failing of which, may be fined up to the extend of Rs. 5000/-.

It is also to notify that, any village council which fail to take action against the SINALI offenders, shall be viewed seriously and all members of such village council shall jointly be punishable for disobedience of 'COURT ORDER'

It is further to order that the punishment of such SINALI offences should be at least a fine of Rs. 5000/- and which may extend up to Rs. 20,000/- (considering the degree of the offence and present day daily wage valuation) in addition to the fineable pig or cock or its valuation. 50% of the fined money should be deposited to the District Council Court and the rest may be utilized by the individual village councils for their village council with proper record. The records of receipt and expenditure by the village council may be audited by the District Council Court from time to time.

NOTIFICATION

It has been brought to our notice that section 41(1)(a) of the Chakma Customary Laws Code, 1997 contains discriminatory expressions in respect of leprosy affected or cured persons, which states as "If the husband is found guilty of being rissua, or breach of trust or negligence in earnings and maintenance of the wife and children, or habitual gambling, or habitual heavy drinking and brawling, or conversion to other religion, or being impotent or any otherwise failure to satisfy natural sexual desire of his wife, or commission of crime, or for having a venereal or other contagious disease." Here the words "or for having a venereal or other contagious disease" are discrimination expressions in respect of leprosy affected or cured persons.

In this regard, the Under Secretary to the Government of Mizoram directed to take necessary steps to amend the said provision in accordance with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P. (C) No. 83/2010 (Federation of Leprosy Organisations (FOLO) & Anr. vs UoI & Ors) by omitting/deleting the words, "or for having a venereal or other contagious disease" from the said section of the said code.

However, currently there is no Executive Committee in CADC, to make necessary amendment of the said provision. Hence, considering the urgency of the matter, the Law & Judicial Department, CADC, hereby declares the expression "or for having a venereal or other contagious disease" under Section 41(1)(a) of the Chakma Customary Laws Code, 1997, as inoperative with immediate effect, until such time the said provision is duly amended by next sitting of the Executive Committee of CADC.

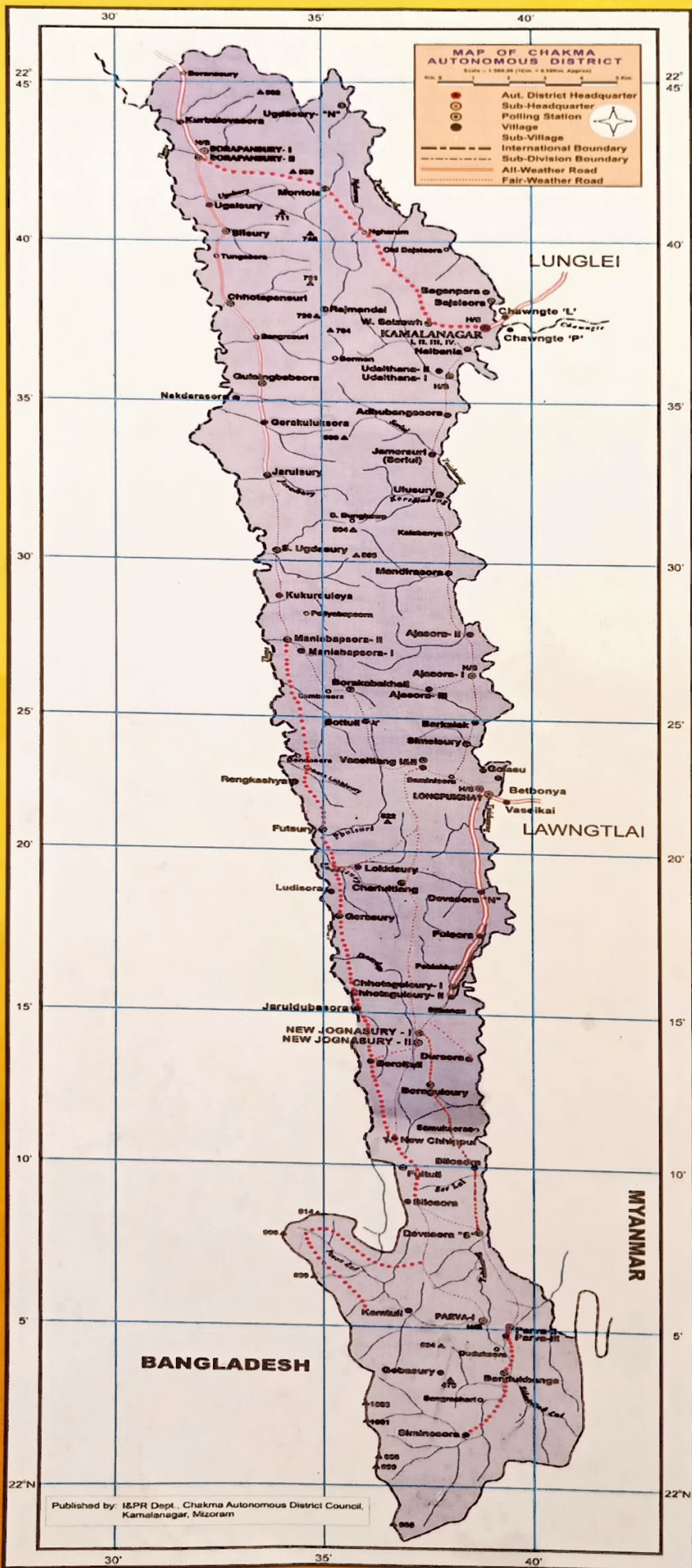
