Power and duties of officers and employees:

 the concern Executive Member for proper transaction of business and The Executive Member i/c A.H & Vety Department is responsible for disposal of business pertaining to department. The District Agriculture Officer i/c A.H Vetty Department is the head of the department. He advises proper observation of rule and regulation for consideration. Since the department does not have sufficient staffs, the department of Agriculture Department assists the Department of A.H & Vety for implementation of various schemes like Piggery& Poultry etc. sanctioned under grant-in-aid of Annual Plan.

Procedure followed in decision making process including channels of supervision and accountability:

- The Executive Committee of Chakma Autonomous District Council is consisting of one Chief Executive Member and seven Executive members. The executive committee is headed by Chief Executive Member. The District Agriculture Officer execute/implements the various schemes after prior approval from concern Executive Member. In any decision making process the concern Executive Member plays vital role for execution of schemes. For implementation of beneficiary schemes of farmers, a beneficiary selection committee has to be constituted by Chief Executive Member.
